Patriotism Talk: "Tunjang Perpaduan"

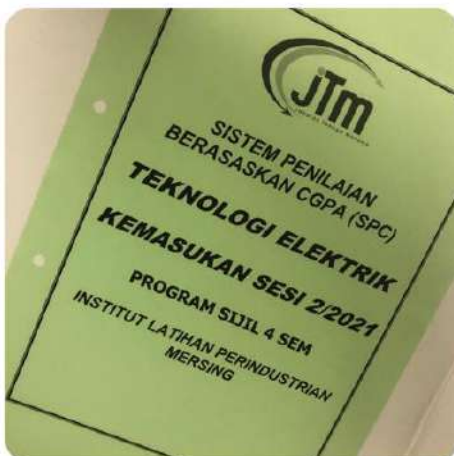
