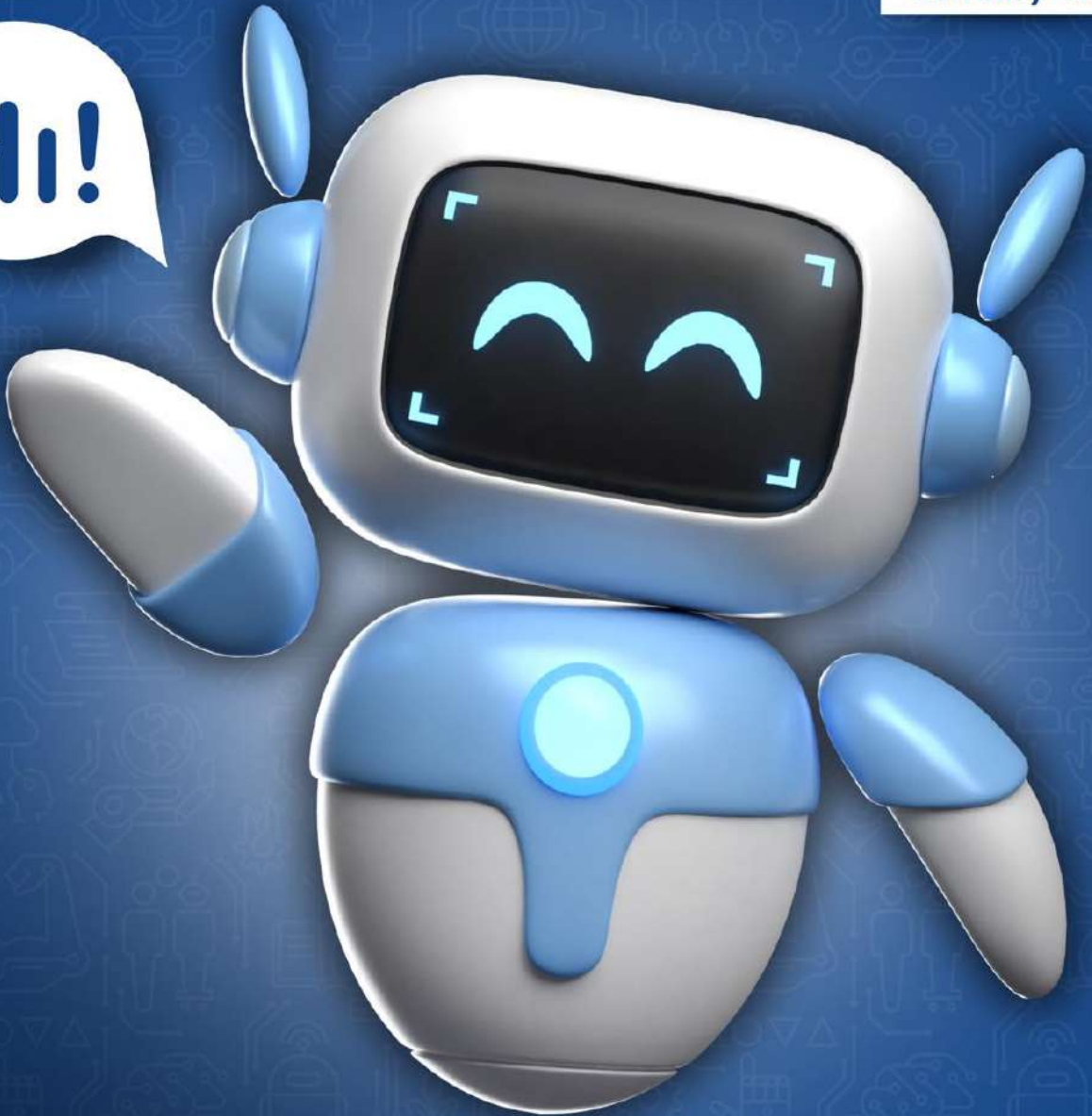

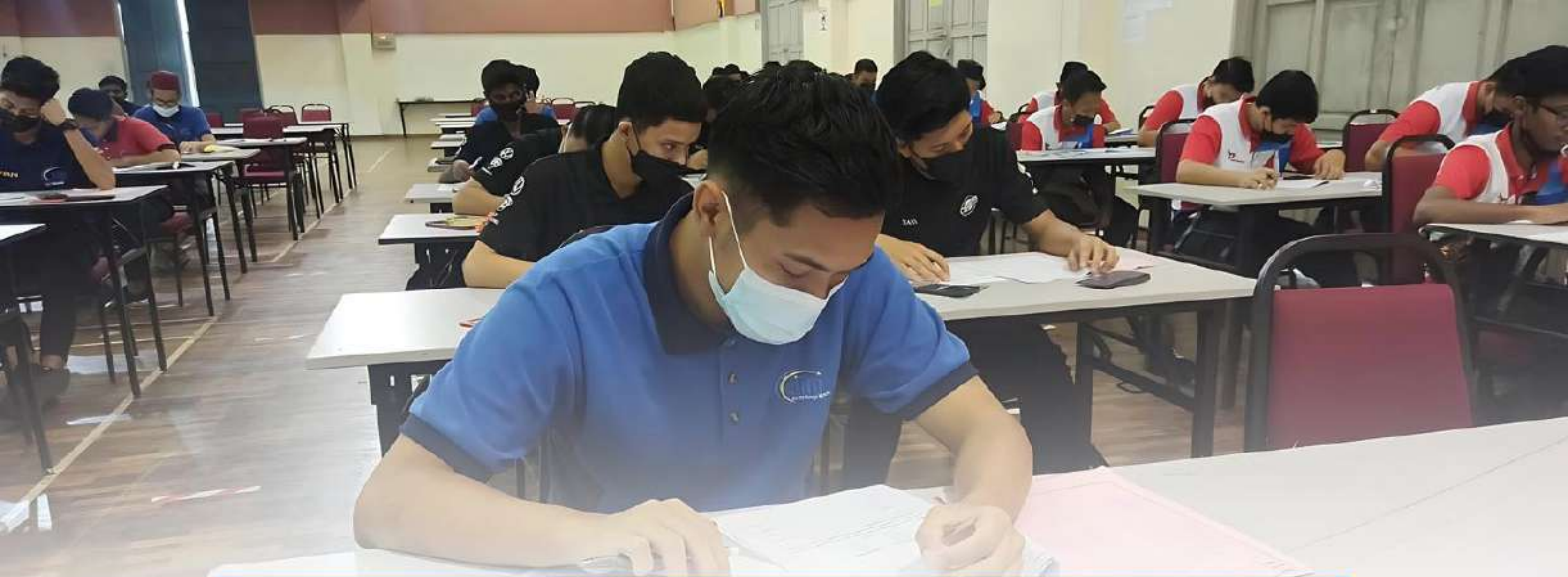

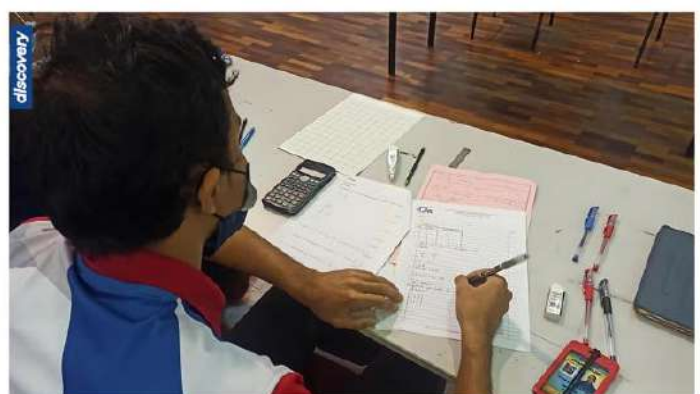
ILJTM FINAL EXAMINATION SESSION 2/2023
